

# CLM (College Level Math) Information

## What is the CLM?

The College Level Math test is designed to place students in the appropriate college math course beyond MAT 1033 (Intermediate Algebra).

## Is it Mandatory?

It is not mandatory; a student may elect to take the CLM in order to place into a higher level math course than MAT 1033. If the student does not take the CLM, they will automatically be placed into MAT 1033.

## Who is Eligible to Take the CLM?

If a student scores 95 or above on Algebra CPT; 19 or above on Math ACT; 440 or above on Math SAT, he/she may take the CLM. A passing score on the CLM is the only way a student will be allowed to take any math classes without first starting in MAT 1033. A score of 440 (SAT), 19 (ACT) or 95 (CPT) does NOT automatically grant access to the higher level math classes.

## CLM Scoring Placement

All students who score 72 to 94 on the Algebra CPT must take MAT 1033. Students who score above that and do not take the CLM will also be placed in MAT 1033.

If a student takes the CLM and receives a **score of 40 or better**, they would be placed into: MAC1105, MGF 1106, MGF 1107 or STA2023

If a student takes the CLM and receives a **score of 70 or better**, they would be placed into: MAC1114, MAC1140, MAC1147 or MAE2801

If a student takes the CLM and receives a **score of 103 or better**, they would be placed into: MAC2233 or MAC2311

Costs involved in taking the CLM:

- ✓ If a student takes the CPT at CFCC, no additional fees are charged to take the CLM
- ✓ If a student wants to re-take the CLM, a \$5 fee is assessed with each retake
- ✓ If a student only took the ACT or SAT, a \$10 testing fee is assessed to take the CLM
